The Provide First Aid in an Education and Care Setting (Childcare First Aid) course equips participants with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively respond to first aid emergencies involving infants, children, and adults in childcare settings. This unit covers the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants and children following guidelines established by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other national clinical bodies.

This course is designed for workers within education and care settings, such as early childhood educators and those overseeing school-age children in outside school hours care and vacation programs
